

Queensland Ballet Academy 2021 Video Auditions Terms and Conditions

Applicant and Parent / Carer Acknowledgement

In submitting your / your child's registration for this event, you agree to and accept the following terms and conditions.

Definitions

The Event: Queensland Ballet Academy 2021 Video Auditions

Queensland Ballet: includes Queensland Ballet Academy

1. I declare that I / my child's (the applicant) details, as stated in the registration form, are true and correct and my / their age on the date of the audition, falls within the stipulated age range for the Program applied for. Queensland Ballet reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of an applicant's registration and to reject or disqualify an applicant from participating in any class or activity.
2. I acknowledge that the video audition that I / my child (the applicant) will submit involves a physical activity and may involve risk of injury or accident while recording this audition. I understand that Queensland Ballet will not be held responsible should any injury or accident occur.
3. I declare that I / my child (the applicant) does not have any pre-existing health or physical conditions which could impede my / their full participation in preparing a video audition. If this is not the case, I will advise Queensland Ballet Academy prior to submitting a video audition, the extent to which I / my child was able to participate.
4. I understand that recording the video audition may be physically strenuous and participation is voluntary, based on an applicant's / parent's / carer's assessment of their fitness, health, cognitive ability to participate and understanding of the material requirements, activities and expected outcomes. Participation is based on an understanding and knowledge that there is a risk of personal injury.
5. By undertaking the video audition process, participants agree that Queensland Ballet is in no way responsible for personal injury or death. Applicants or their parents / carers are responsible for ensuring their own physical and mental health during and after recording the video audition including injury rehabilitation and general post-class care.
6. The applicant or their parent / carer agrees to indemnify Queensland Ballet against any injuries or damage to persons or loss or wrongful death or loss or theft of property, whether caused by negligence or otherwise while participating in the filming of the audition video and associated activities.

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7. I understand that it is preferred that applicants seek approval from their dance teacher/s before registering for an audition for Queensland Ballet Academy.

8. I declare that if my / my child's audition is successful, I / they do not have any pre-existing health or physical conditions which could impede my / their full participation and completion of the dance program, and understand that I / my child will be required to have a General Practitioner complete a full medical check (provided by Queensland Ballet Academy), as part of my / my child's enrolment in the Program.

9. I have attached the supporting documents and video audition link as requested in the audition registration and in-line with the provided, endorsed International Audition Pre-selection Guidelines.

10. I understand that the audition panel's decision is final and that no correspondence will be entered into regarding audition results. Applicants applying for the Academy Program, please note that as this program is run in collaboration with the Department of Education there is an appeals process available to unsuccessful applicants applying on the grounds of procedural fairness only. Please note that the appeals process will close seven days after the results for the auditions are issued.

11. I understand that the information, images, video and documents that I provide as requested within the Queensland Ballet Academy Audition Registration, will be used by Queensland Ballet for program audition application and selection purposes only. Students applying for the Academy Program, please note that Queensland Ballet Academy may share elements of the information you provide with Kelvin Grove State College where required, to complete the program selection process.

12. Queensland Ballet Academy acknowledges that submitting a video audition in lieu of a live audition is not normal or standard industry practice. However, due to the COVID-19 situation in 2020, and in the interest of fairness and equity to participants residing outside of Queensland, all participants applying for the Academy Program and Pre-Professional Program must audition in this way. Queensland Ballet Academy also reserves the right to make adjustments to a student's levels (up or down within the Program) where it is deemed beneficial to the student development, once the Program commences in 2021.

13. Queensland Ballet Academy reserves the right to request the applicant or parent / carer to resubmit a video if the original is lost or invalid due to technological error or low quality visual.
