Sure to send hearts aflutter, we begin our Brisbane season with *Giselle*, a year after it was cancelled due to 2022's historic flooding event. This quintessential Romantic-era ballet has been holding audiences spellbound since its Parisian première more than 150 years ago.

In June, prepare to travel through time and place as we present our new triple bill Trilogy. Cathy Marston's world première My Brilliant Career is based on the acclaimed Australian novel by Stella Maria 'Miles Franklin', and explores the vivacious Australian spirit. It's also an incredible classic Australian film. To have Cathy, one of the world's most highly regarded and imaginative choreographers, create this original work for us is truly amazing. We are so proud to present the Australian première of Jack Lister's wistful and atmospherically cinematic A Brief Nostalgia as a co-production with Birmingham Royal Ballet. And Christopher Bruce's Rooster is a celebration of the vibrant, colourful 1960s, featuring songs by The Rolling Stones and more.

Premièring at the new Talbot Theatre, *The Little Mermaid* will delight audiences of all ages in this next instalment of the My First Ballet series. Choreographed by the inventive and talented Paul Boyd, we are thrilled to bring this visually spectacular and enchanting story to life for families and children.

Always a sell-out, our contemporary season, *Bespoke*, offers three vivid, original works by three renowned Australian choreographers. Remi Wörtmeyer is an award-winning dancer and choreographer, and one of Australia's most successful international artists. With a performing career spanning 25 years, Paul Boyd is a talented choreographer whose works have been performed by Queensland Ballet, The Australian Ballet, and The Royal Ballet School among many others. And award-winning choreographer Natalie Weir is known for her highly physical partner work, and touching insight into humanity.

August brings your chance to witness the rising stars of the dance world in our *Queensland Ballet Academy Gala*. Always a stunning season presenting the very best new talent, the *Gala* will showcase a program of inspiring classical and dynamic contemporary works.

From the modern era to the glamour and romance of the golden age: due to popular demand, I can't wait for our 2023 blockbuster, Derek Deane's *Strictly Gershwin*. This melting pot of classical ballet, singing, tap and ballroom dancing - to the best of Gershwin's sensational music - makes it one of the most stunning productions of all time! Queensland Ballet performed a sold-out season in 2016 to audience and critical acclaim, and we've been asked so many times to bring it back.

We finish our Brisbane season with the evercharming festive tradition, *The Nutcracker*. A favourite of mine and so many others, it's the perfect Christmas experience for families of all generations. If you haven't experienced our production of pure Christmas magic onstage, be sure to get in quick as tickets always sell fast!

Meanwhile, regional audiences are in for a treat as we take the late Liam Scarlett's *A Midsummer Night's Dream* to the Gold Coast, Townsville, Mackay and Toowoomba across February to April. Scarlett's rendition of Shakespeare's fantastical masterpiece is beautifully choreographed, and will no doubt delight audiences of all ages.

# Trilogy My Brilliant Career / A Brief Nostalgia / Rooster

### 16 - 25 JUNE 2023 PLAYHOUSE, QPAC

Australian spirit and passion swirls into a Scandi noir cinematic experience, followed by the toe-tapping energy of the '60s.

Based on the celebrated novel, My Brilliant Career by Stella Maria 'Miles Franklin', this world première work by British choreographer Cathy Marston is an exploration of the Australian spirit and passion, against a vivid Australian landscape.

Part ballet, part Scandi noir in style, Jack Lister's A Brief Nostalgia premièred in London in 2019 as a co-production with Birmingham Royal Ballet. Wistful and atmospherically cinematic, this abstract work explores the inevitability of the memories we collect, and how we respond when they are all we have left.

Music, colour, and rock 'n' roll swagger collide in Christopher Bruce's Rooster - a celebration of the swinging '60s! Featuring toe-tapping tunes by The Rolling Stones including Paint it Black, Not Fade Away and Little Red Rooster, this high-energy production resurrects the 1960s with an ironic look at the era.






