Meet Ivan Gil-Ortega: Queensland Ballet's New Artistic Director

Ivan is a celebrated ballet professional with over 25 years of experience, having held prominent roles such as Principal Dancer, Assistant Director, Artistic Consultant, Freelance Rehearsal Director, Stager, and Coach. His career is distinguished by artistic excellence, technical proficiency, and captivating character interpretations, all of which highlight his elegance and exceptional partnering skills. Since 2007, Ivan has represented multiple international ballet companies, directing and staging major productions worldwide. His linguistic skills further enhance his contributions in the global ballet community. Born in Spain, Ivan is fluent in Spanish, English, German, Italian, and Portuguese.

From 1997 to 2007, Ivan was a principal artist Stuttgart Ballet, Germany, before continuing his work as a principal dancer with Dutch National Ballet (2007-2008), where he performed in numerous acclaimed productions. Recognised internationally, Ivan has also made significant contributions as a quest artist with prestigious companies, including the Ballet of Santiago de Chile, Bayerisches Staatsballet Munich, Finnish National Ballet, Croatian National Ballet, West Australian Ballet, Ballet del Teatro Massimo de Palermo, Teatro del Maggio Musicale Fiorentino, Teatro dell'Arena di Verona, Teatro San Carlo di Napoli, Nuremberg Staatsballet, Universal Ballet of Korea, National Ballet of Korea, and Slovenian National Ballet.

Notably, Ivan has performed in principal roles specifically created for him by renowned choreographers such as Hans van Manen, William Forsythe, and Goyo Montero. As a ballet assistant and stager, he has worked alongside luminary choreographers like Carlos Acosta, Christian Spuck, Goyo Montero, and Derek Deane, contributing to critically acclaimed productions such as *Swan Lake* and *Romeo & Juliet* with the English National Ballet; *Nutcracker, Cinderella*, and *The Sleeping Beauty* at Staatstheater Nürnberg; *Chacona* for Birmingham Royal Ballet; *The Sleeping Beauty* for Maggio Musicale Fiorentino; *The Lady of the Camellias* at Teatro San Carlo in Naples and the National Ballet of Croatia; and *Nutcracker, Hamlet, Romeo & Juliet, Swan Lake, Le Fantôme de l'Opéra*, and *The Lady of the Camellias* for the Shanghai Ballet.

In 2016 and 2023, Ivan contributed to Queensland Ballet's sell-out production *Strictly Gershwin*, serving as the right-hand man to Choreographer and Director Derek Deane. Between 2020 and 2021, he worked as Rehearsal Director and Stager for the Bolshoi Ballet's world premiere of *Orlando*, choreographed by Christian Spuck (now the Artistic Director of Berlin Ballet). Ivan also played a key role in launching Carlos Acosta's world premiere of *Carmen* at the Royal Opera House with the Royal Ballet.

In addition to his artistic roles, Ivan holds prestigious advisory positions. He served as Vice President of Le Prix de Lausanne in 2019, has been a Jury Member for the Youth America Grand Prix since 2019, and was President of the Jury for the Certamen Coreográfico Burgos New York in the 2014/2015 edition. In 2009, Ivan was honoured with the *Premio Positano de Danza – Léonide Massine* for his substantial contributions to the art of ballet.
