#### POSITION PURPOSE

Technical Coordinator (Staging), under the supervision of the Technical Manager (Staging), is responsible for maintaining and executing the physical production of scenic elements, materials, supplies and hardware to a consistently excellent and safe standard via the successful coordination of storage, handling and staging for each program of Queensland Ballet's performance seasons.

In addition, this valuable member of the Production Department coordinates the maintenance and upkeep of Queensland Ballet's Production facilities, assets and equipment to ensure they are safe and effective.

# **REPORTING RELATIONSHIPS**

This position reports to the Technical Manager (Staging) and liaises directly with the Director of Production Services, Head of Production and Technical Manager (Lighting) as needed.

The Technical Coordinator (Staging) supervises casual employees and contractors.

# WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR

You will be a flexible, detail oriented and dependable team player ideally with a technical theatre background and a passion for the Arts and/or ballet. The role requires a motivated self-starter, with a hands-on approach to staging and the ability to work collaboratively with others, applying a proactive solution focussed approach.

# RESPONSIBILITIES

#### Staging Role & Coordination

- In consultation with the Technical Manager (Staging), coordinate the Staging team for each Queensland Ballet season, tour and any other events.
- Perform the role of Deputy Head Mechanist for Queensland Ballet productions staged in QPAC and other venues, and also perform the role of Head Mechanist, as required.
- Travel as Deputy Head Mechanist for Queensland Ballet touring productions regionally, nationally and internationally or Head Mechanist as required.
- With other Production Staff, facilitate effective and cooperative work relations within the department and between the department staff and the rest of the Company.

• Coordinate the implementation and maintenance of Staging Department Work Health and Safety policy, procedures and practices. Advise the Technical Manager (Staging) and other Production Staff to ensure the appropriate risk management processes and Work Health and Safety procedures are written and applied to each production and Staging Department activity.

# Mechanical & Scenic Coordination

- Within the scope of the Company's facilities coordinate and construct any set, furniture or prop items required for new or remount productions including substitute rehearsal elements as directed.
- With the Technical Manager (Staging), coordinate and execute all activities in the Company's workshops including construction and maintenance.
- Maintain staging assets and associated records.
- Maintain a complete Staging Department archive of each Queensland Ballet production, tour or major event including documentation, plots and photos.
- Maintain a complete inventory of Queensland Ballet's scenic elements, tools, rigging, consumables and equipment.
- With the Technical Manager (Staging) coordinate the pre-production preparation through to execution of each Queensland Ballet production to ensure the safe installation, operation and maintenance of all rigging and scenic related assets of Queensland Ballet and maintain associated records.
- Make recommendations for the repair, maintenance, hire, or purchase of materials and accessories for Queensland Ballet as directed.
- With the Technical Manager (Staging) coordinate the hire of company equipment and keep records accordingly.
- Assist Technical Manager (Staging) and other Production Staff in the planning, budgeting and management of each production.
- Attend production meetings and rehearsals as necessary.

# **KEY CRITERIA**

- 1. Tertiary qualifications in technical management for theatre or a related field, combined with a minimum of 2+ years' experience in staging coordination and strong skills in set construction, carpentry and workshop maintenance.
- 2. Excellent written and verbal communication skills, combined with the ability to effectively maintain relationships with internal and external stakeholders.
- 3. Demonstrated strong administrative skills in maintaining technical databases, file management, proficiency in Microsoft suite and experience with CAD software.
- 4. Demonstrated knowledge and experience in the creation, implementation and maintenance of Work Health and Safety procedures.
- 5. A keen ability to multi-task, collaborate and to thrive in a busy environment.
