Applicant and Parent/Carer Acknowledgement

In submitting your/your child's registration for this event, you agree to and accept the following terms and conditions.

DEFINITIONS

The Event Queensland Ballet Academy 2022 Video Auditions

Queensland Ballet includes Queensland Ballet Academy

1. I declare that I/my child's (the applicant) details, as stated in the registration form, are true and correct and my/their age on the date of the audition, falls within the stipulated age range for the Program applied for. Queensland Ballet reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of an applicant's registration and to reject or disqualify an ineligible applicant from participating in any application process, class or activity.
2. I declare that I/my child (the applicant) does not have any pre-existing health or physical conditions which could impede my/their full participation in preparing a video audition. If this is not the case, I will advise QB Academy prior to submitting a video audition, of the reason and extent to which I/my child was able to participate. I understand that applicants and/or their parents/carers are responsible for ensuring the applicant's physical and mental health during and after recording the video audition including injury rehabilitation and general post-class care.
3. I understand that recording the video audition will involve physical activity, may be physically strenuous and participation is voluntary, based on an applicant's/parent/carers' assessment of their fitness, health, cognitive ability to participate and understanding of the material requirements, activities and expected outcomes. Participation is based on an understanding and knowledge that there is a risk of personal injury. I understand that Queensland Ballet will not be held responsible should any incident, injury or accident occur during the creation of the video.
4. The applicant or their parent/carers agrees to indemnify Queensland Ballet against any injuries or damage to persons or loss or wrongful death or loss or theft of property, whether caused by negligence or otherwise while participating in the filming of the audition video and associated activities.
5. I understand that it is preferred that applicants seek approval from their dance teacher/s before registering and preparing a video audition for Queensland Ballet Academy.
6. I understand that I must submit a completed Physiotherapy Screening Form (provided by Queensland Ballet Academy) which has been completed by a qualified Physiotherapist, along with the video audition for the application to be considered.

7. I declare that if my/my child's audition is successful, I/they do not have any pre-existing health or physical conditions which could impede my/their full participation and completion of the dance program and understand that I/my child will be required to have a General Practitioner complete a full medical check (provided by Queensland Ballet Academy), prior to enrolment in the Program.

8. I will attach all required supporting documents, photographs and video audition link as requested in the audition registration, and in-line with the provided, endorsed International Audition Pre-Selection Guidelines

9. I understand that the audition panel's decision is final and that no correspondence will be entered into regarding audition results.

10. I understand that the information, images, video and documents that I provide as requested within the Queensland Ballet Academy Audition Registration, will be used by Queensland Ballet for program audition application and selection purposes only. If applying for the Academy Program, application data will be shared with Kelvin Grove State College.

11. Queensland Ballet Academy acknowledges that submitting a video audition in lieu of a live audition is not normal or standard industry practice. However, due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, some participants residing outside of Queensland who are applying for the Academy Program and Pre-Professional Program may need to audition in this way due to government restrictions and state border closures.

12. Queensland Ballet Academy reserves the right to adjust a student's level (up or down within the Program) where it is deemed beneficial to the student's development once the Program commences.

13. Queensland Ballet Academy reserves the right to request the applicant or parent/carer to resubmit a video if the original is lost or invalid due to technical or quality issues.
